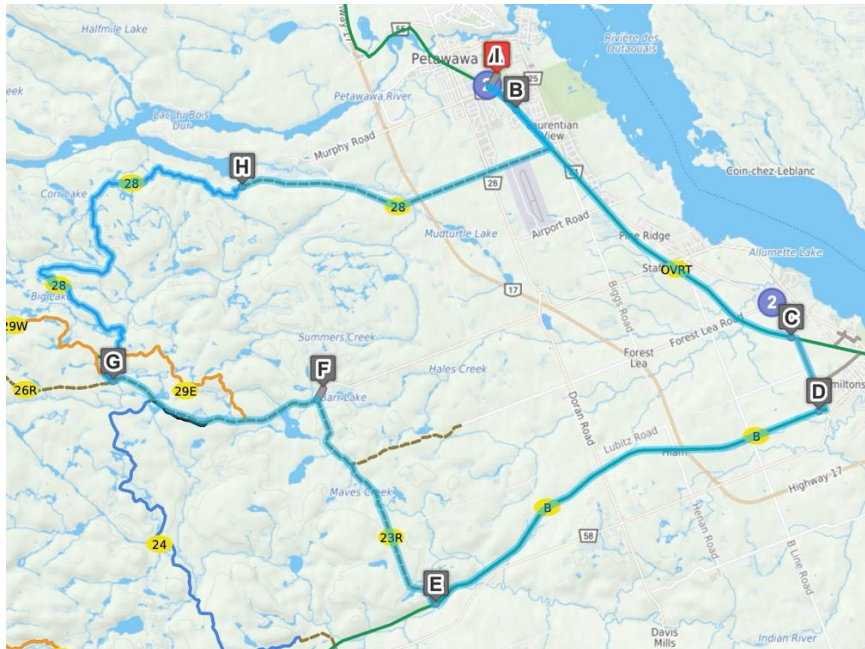


This exciting group ATV excursion takes you deep into the heart of the woods, where you'll experience all the ATViing in the Petawawa area has to offer, from paved roads, to former rail corridors to rugged trails. Soak in the beauty of nature like never before. Whether you're an experienced rider or new to the adventure, this ride promises scenic views, and unforgettable moments.

Your adventure begins at 1:00 pm when we depart from the Petawawa Civic Center. Our route will take us along the Algonquin Trail and the B Trail, two former rail corridors. We will proceed to Barron Canyon Road (via Station Hill Road) to the Algonquin Portage Store for an Ice Cream stop. Then back along Barron Canyon Road to RCATV Trail 28 popping out at Black Bay Road and then back to the Civic Center for dinner and music.



The route is approximately 64km and should take 3.5 to 4 hours at an easily pace.

Important Info:

- All machines must have an OFATV trail Pass. Passes can be purchased online at <https://permits2.ofatv.org/user/permit/buy>, indicate Renfrew County ATV as your club of choice as this brings revenue back to maintain RCATV trails. Rates (incl. tax): annual \$150, 3 day \$55, 1 day \$25
- Always keep your lights on while driving.
- Stay with the group.

- Ensure the machine behind you is always visible. You are responsible for the machine behind you, if you cannot see them, please slow down or stop until you do.
- Drive within your abilities.
